Entry

Online entry at skireg.com. Mail-in entries are not accepted for the 2021 season. Online registration closes 72-hours prior to the start of the event. Available spaces will be filled in the order they were received on the waitlist. Per NHARA policy, cancellations received more than 72 hours prior to the start of the event will receive a full refund.

Coaches

Coaches must register for the race HERE. Coaches must have a current USSA Alpine Coach (w/ Officials) membership.

Run Order

The first run start order is by USSA points rank and the top seed (15) is randomized. The second run is BIBO flip-30.

DSQs will be announced via loudspeaker and Jury Radio after review of the Gate Judge cards. A protest must include a deposit of \$50 and be submitted within the 15-minute protest period (ACR 644). Protests not submitted on time or without the protest fee will not be considered.

The decision to run DNF and DSQ 2nd-run will be made at the team captains' meeting. If granted a 2nd-run, DNF and DSQ will run at the end of the field in bib number order.

Race Day Schedule of Events

Race Course: Burden Trail Homologation 10691/11/12 (2022)

- 7:30 am Lift opens for course set crew, jury, coaches, and course workers
- 8:15 am Team Captian's Bib pickup opens, lodge main deck
- 8:30 am Lift opens to the public
- 8:45 am Registration closed; Course open for inspection (ALPHA BY CLUB)
- 9:15 am Course inspection entry closed
- 9:20 am Course closed
- 9:25 am Forerunner
- 9:30 am First Competitor

The 2nd run schedule will be determined by Jury and announced at the conclusion of the first run.

The schedule for the afternoon race will be set at the conclusion of the morning race. The estimated start time is 12:30 pm.

Bib Pickup

The Team Captain will pick up bibs on the upstairs deck of the lodge. The Team Captains must provide the day-of-event COVID screening for athletes and coaches. Racers will return bibs as they exit the finish area at the conclusion of the second run.

Inspection

The inspection procedure will be determined by the Jury and announced at the TCM. Bibs must be worn with the number visible. Freeskiing is not permitted on the race hill at any time. Please ski responsibly at all times, violators can be sanctioned

Per USSA COVID Guidelines each team will be assigned an inspection entry time at 3 minute intervals. Please respect the physical distancing of at least 1 gate from teams. There will only be time for a single inspection run.

Results and Awards:

Complete results will be posted to the USSA Live Timing and NHARA website after the event. Awards will be given to the top 3 overall and top 3 U16's. Per USSA Competition Guidelines there will be no awards ceremony.

COVID-19 Guidelines and Information

New Hampshire COVID-19 Guidelines

COVID-19 Screening

48 to 24 hours before the start of the event you will receive an email from the registration system with a link to complete a COVID screening questionnaire. It can also be found If the screening questionnaire is not completed 24-hours before the start of the event, the athlete may be withdrawn from the race and the spot allocated to an athlete from the waitlist.

Another COVID Screening will be done the day of the event by the Team Captain. The results of this screening must be provided to pick bibs and tickets for the team.
