Pre Screening Questionnaire COVID needs to be completed by Athletes, Coaches, Staff and Volunteers between Feb 7, Sunday noon- Monday, Feb 8th at noon. If this is not submitted, you will not be allowed in race series.

Daily Symptom check needs to be completed each day of race by Athletes, Coaches, Staff and Volunteers if this is not submitted you will not be able to race in the series.

Athlete/Parent Lift tickets will not be sold at the Squaw Valley ticket window.

The Team Coach will give out all Athlete Lift Tickets and Parent Tickets. These will be given out at the 7:30am meeting in front of Squaw Valley Competition Services Building.

Inspection Teams must maintain at least six feet of distance between one another during inspection.

Remind your athlete to bring their Far West bibs to the race.

Facial Coverings – Squaw Valley /Alpine Meadows Facial Covering Policy - The facial covering must cover the nose and mouth entirely and be made of at least two (2) layers of tightly woven material. Facial coverings are required in lift lines and on ALL CHAIR LIFTS, while walking through the village, indoors, parking lots and in all other outdoor areas. Athletes can remove the face covering in the start; do not linger in the finish area. Once the athlete has completed their run, they are required to put their face covering back on and exit the finish area.

Plan to boot up and keep your items in the car.

Those you would like to watch their athlete race will be required to limit their presence near the race venue to 5 minutes or less. No congregating on the hill or in the finish area will be permitted. Parents/Guardians who are not following our resorts social distancing or other guidelines will be asked to leave the premises.
