All clubs/athletes will need representation. - No skiing outside the race arena prior to 8:30. - Inspection procedure- side slip straight down the fallline / In and out of the course - Maintain appropriate distance - Please keep your course inspection moving along so that we don't create bottlenecks on the hill and can keep to the schedule. - TCM the evening prior to the race. Notification sent to registered coaches. - Spectators are stay in designated areas as to not block the public way. Announcement of Jury and course setters.</p> <p>Review of Race Program Schedule, Program posted on Live Timing as well as Start Lists.</p> <p>USSS COVID-19 Protocols to be followed. Bibs and Lift Passes provided to Team Representative or Coach for distribution to their athletes.</p> <p>The medical plan has been reviewed by the Jury and is found to meet the requirements for the level of competition. It is accepted as presented. Concussion policy reviewed. Ski patrol will be available on the mountain and at top of the race course. Sleds should be located at the top of the course.</p> <p>Stop the bleed kit will be stationed at the start and on the hill. No drill, skis, bags left on the race hill.</p> <p>Course inspection procedures reviewed – In and out AND Side Slip straight down the fall line. Coaches / course maintenance workers should slip straight down and push any loose snow out.</p> <p>Controlled free skiing on all available trails. No skiing on the race hill during race.</p> <p>DSQ's for both Women and Men will be posted at pump building in front of Timing Building with a 15-minute protest period after the end of each Men's run. Ref Report will also be conveyed to coaches as a courtesy.</p> <p>DNF's and DSQ's will run second run</p> <p>Some B-Net being removed after race. Request assistance from coaches.</p> <p>Awards will be provided for the top 5 finishes for girls and top 5 finishes for boys as well as overall U14</p>
