2. Women 1st Run Course # 1 (Skier's Left Side)
3. Men's 1st Run Course # 2 (Skier's Right Side)
4. Women's 2nd Run Course # 1 (Skier's Right Side)
5. Men's 2nd Run Course # 2 (Skier's Left Side)
6. Team captains will pick up bibs and RFID cards for their athletes in front of the timing shack between 7 and 7:30.
7. Teams will be responsible for lost bibs by their athletes.
