The DSQ trail is the only trail that will be open for warm-up skiing prior to 9:00am. Please do not ski anywhere else as there is machinery operating on the mountain still.

Please ski slow after the public is allowed on the mountain at 9:00. If Ski Patrol thinks you ski too fast, they may pull your pass.

The Avalanche run is a SLOW skiing area. Please ski very slow in this area.

We are asking athletes to check in at the start to see if we need help with course maintenance. Athletes will go with a race crew worker. Men slip for the women, women slip for the men. No equipment while doing course maintenance.
